## **Election Day Approaches for House District 58 Special General Election**

**February 19, 2010 - Tampa, FL** – Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections, Earl Lennard, reminds voters that the Special General Election for State House District 58 is Tuesday, February 23, 2010.

The Special General Election is open to all eligible registered voters in State House, District 58. Sample ballots may be found online at [www.VoteHillsborough.org](http://www.VoteHillsborough.org).

The Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Eligible voters in line at 7:00 p.m. will be allowed to vote.

Voters are advised to bring current and valid signature and photo identification to expedite the voting process.

Voters who received a Vote By Mail (absentee) ballot but who wish to vote at their precinct on Election Day are advised to bring their Vote By Mail ballot with them to the polling site so that a poll worker can cancel the Vote By Mail ballot.

House District 58 represents 49 precincts in parts of West Tampa, Town n Country and Seminole Heights. Also affected are parts of Oak Grove, Egypt Lake, Wellswood and the Floriland Mall area.
