PROCEEDINGS:

**BOND HEARING**

Court verifies financial affidavit with defendant. Defendant restates his request to have the Federal Public Defender's Office represent him. Government requests detention due to danger to community and risk of flight. Government proffers information in favor of detention. Defendant argues in favor of release. Court discusses letters which were submitted to the Clerk's Office. Parties do not object to the letters being made part of the court file. Government makes brief rebuttal. Court sets bond in the amount of \$200,000.00 secured with Nebbia requirement. Defendant is subject to Pretrial Services supervision; surrender all passports (2); all immediate family members are to surrender their passports; GPS home monitoring, the most intensive device and can only leave his residence for attorney meetings and court appearances, he may leave for church services but must get pre-approval by Pretrial Services; reside with parents; parents are to be third party custodians; prohibited from having any access to the internet; shall not possess any firearms or dangerous weapons; every adult member in the home must execute a 4<sup>th</sup> Amendment waiver; travel is restricted to the Middle District of Florida. Government will file a notice of appeal.
